HUBBLE BUBBLE

(The **White Hart** pub, on Constable Rance's London beat (STUD), featured this rather tasty dish.)
Try it - you'll like it!

1 lb. potatoes, peeled, cooked & sliced
5 slices bacon, diced 1 onion, finely chopped
8 oz. pork sausage links, sliced
2 eggs $\frac{1}{2}$ c. milk Salt & pepper


Line bottom of greased baking dish with half of the potatoes. Mix together the bacon, onion & sausage; place on top of tatties. Lightly beat eggs with milk, salt and pepper. Pour into dish. Cover top with remaining potatoes. Bake in 350° oven for 45 min., or 'til eggs are set. **Serves 4.**
