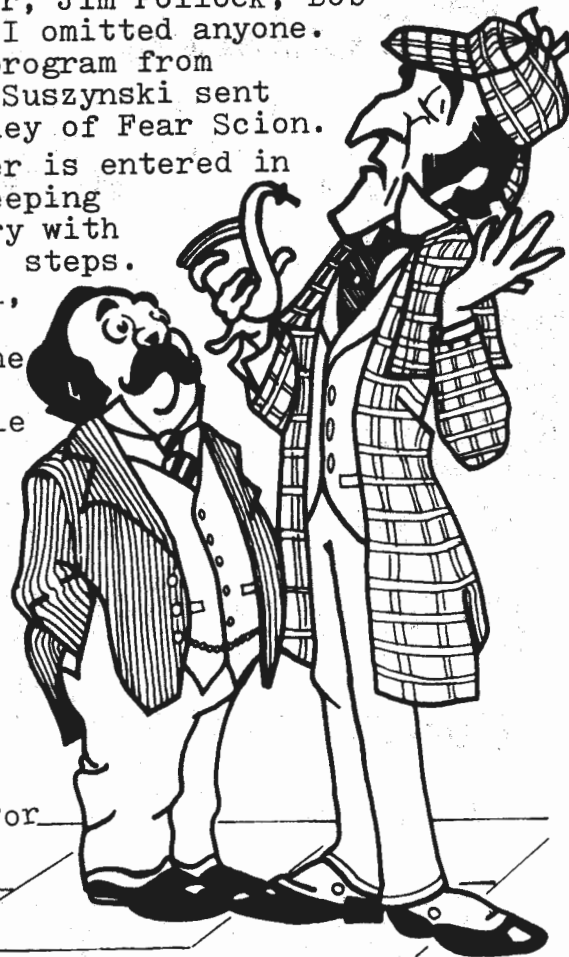

CHIDDINGLY HOT POT

(This tasty Sussex dish is a great favourite of Sherlock Holmes after a long day's work at the apiary.)

- 2 lbs stewing beef, cut into 1" cubes
- 1 tablespoon salt
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 2 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 3 medium-sized potatoes, peeled, sliced & divided
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 10½ oz. can condensed onion soup
- ½ cup water
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- ¼ teaspoon paprika

In a 13x9x2" casserole place in an attractive manner potatoes & celery. Mix onion soup, water & Worcestershire sauce together and pour over vegetables. Cover with foil.

Bake 'til meat & potatoes are tender, c. 1½ hrs. Remove foil and sprinkle with paprika. Bake, uncovered, 'til potatoes are golden, about 30 min. Yields 6 portions.

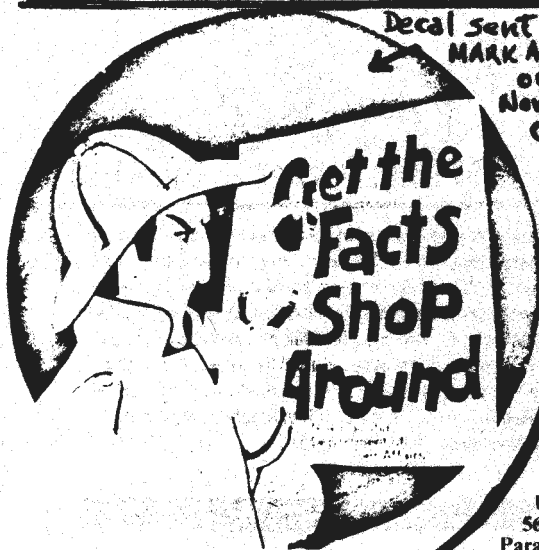

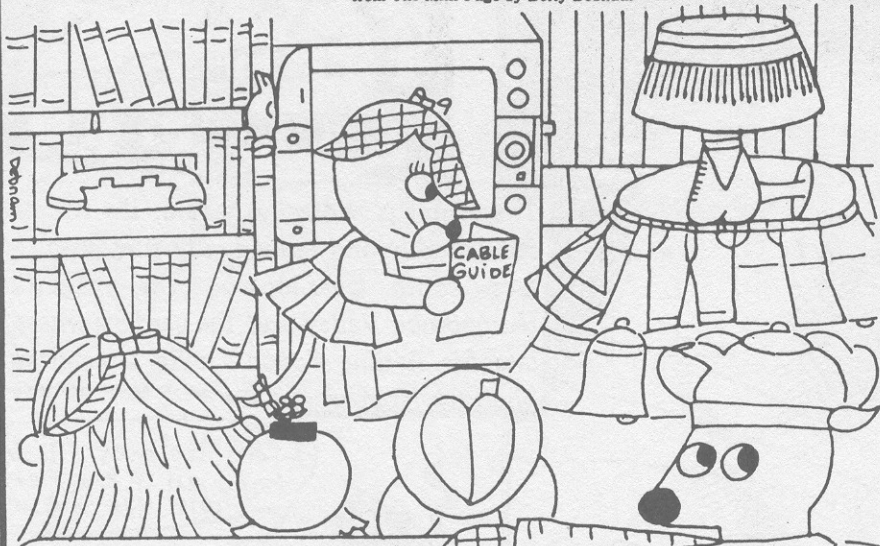


During the 1983 season, Asolo State Theater audiences will prowl the foggy streets of London with Sherlock Holmes.

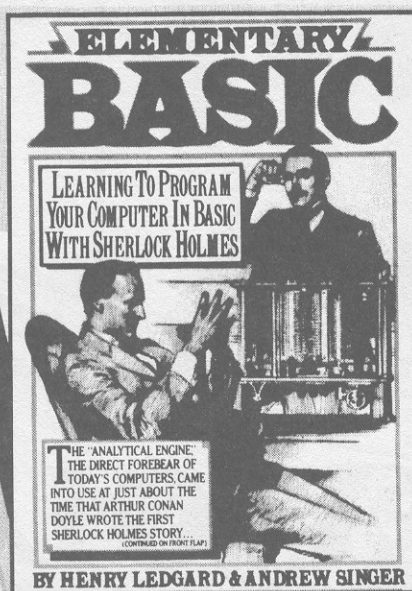

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLING: Computers may be reprogramming our lives, but if you still don't know an input from an algorithm, plug into Henry Ledgard and Andrew Singer's "Elementary Basic" and "Elementary Pascal" (Vintage; \$20 each hardcover, \$12.95 paper), two novel computer-language guides specifically calculated for non-tech types. Both feature that inimitable pipe-puffing, violin-playing, deerstalker-capped sleuth, Sherlock Holmes, who's updated for 1982 and solves such cases as "The Adventure of the Bathing Machine," "A Study in Cigar Ash" plus "The Adventure of Clergyman Peter" by feeding clues into a computer. While tracking the detective step by step, you'll absorb programming theory and practice. Entertaining reads as well as invaluable business tools, these books are bound to make the electronic revolution, well, elementary. —K.T. MACLAY

Walter Klinefelter's *The Origins of Sherlock Holmes* (Gaslight Publications, 112 East Second St., Bloomington, IN 47401, 1982, \$10.95) is one of that minority of Holmes studies that admits Conan Doyle invented him. Klinefelter discusses the origins of the great detective (no surprises here) as well as Irene Adler, Professor Moriarty, and other characters and incidents. Edward A. Merrill's "For the Sake of the Trust": *Sherlock Holmes and the Musgrave Ritual* (Gaslight, 1982, \$10.95), a volume in the Sherlock Holmes monograph series, is for a more specialized audience. Doyle's "The Musgrave Ritual" is reprinted and followed by several chapters of highly technical discussions of its solution. [6]
